

PROVIDING DIAPERS AND OTHER BASIC NEEDS FOR CENTRAL TEXAS FAMILIES

Founded in 2013, the Austin Diaper Bank is the only organization in Central Texas focused on providing diapers, period supplies and incontinence supplies to families living in poverty.

Our work helps alleviate monthly costs that would otherwise be a burden for

struggling families, and provides them with basic items that are absolutely essential to good health and well-being.

The Austin Diaper Bank entered 2020 with modest plans: increase distribution to our partner agencies, expand our Bright Spot program into more schools in Austin, and start the search for a bigger warehouse. As the whole world began to comprehend the magnitude of the COVID-19 impact on all of our lives, the Austin Diaper Bank realized that the original plan for the year was going to have to be scrapped. Focus quickly shifted to immediate relief to newly unemployed families. For the first time in our history, we instituted a direct-to-the-public drive-thru diaper distribution from March through the fall to help more than 15,000 families navigate the pandemic crisis.

Without our normal reliance on volunteers due to COVID restrictions, the Diaper Bank leaned heavily on our Board to prepare distributions, greet families in the drive-thru operations and be extra arms and legs for whatever was needed. We also remotely onboarded five new board members during the year. We are excited by the unique insights and resumes that they bring to our Board. This growth will help maintain and expand our outreach for years to come.

As the need for diapers and basic needs increased in our community, so did our ability to directly impact families. In 2020 we distributed 1.7 million diapers and period supplies, nearly doubling our 2019 distributions. Diaper demand in Central Texas is not declining and the Austin Diaper Bank is in an even better position in 2021 to meet those demands head-on.







